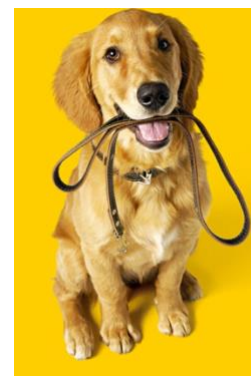

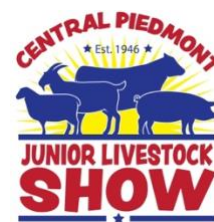
District 4-H Dog Artistic Expression Contest

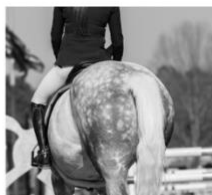
