

District 4-H Poultry & Rabbit Shows & Egg Contest

The district is hosting a poultry & rabbit show & new for this year is the egg contest. Youth with their own rabbit can register to show. Each registered youth to show the poultry show will receive 5 laying hen chicks late September. Youth will go through a series of virtual workshops on chick brooding, housing and health. The show date is Saturday March 15th. The cost is \$25 which is paid to Rockingham County 4-H or you can use your scholarships \$. All participants must submit a record book on their project by February 28 in order to show. Register online by August 16 to participate in the poultry show and receive chicks.
